The BQR was published four times in FY 2023, with a circulation of approximately 1,700. Recordings of the GTS presentations were subsequently posted on the GTS Library page of the GCRG website. This outstanding educational event was followed by a two-week long, river-based training session on the Colorado River through Grand Canyon for 22 guide participants, with 9 speakers from the National Park Service, affiliated tribes, and the science community.
